Welcome to the February 2023 jobs report. There has been another decrease of over 75 open positions compared to last month, marking the lowest number of jobs in the industry since April 2021.



Two major companies have removed over 100 job posts from their websites, but the number of indie roles increased.


We have added 5 new companies to our database this month.



Two major companies removed or closed over three quarters of their open positions, while three AAA studios removed over a third of their available roles.

Only 3 regions of the UK had a greater number of job opportunities than last month, and some smaller hubs lost a large proportion of their games jobs due to the reduced opportunities of one major AAA company.
